

Maths

In maths the children will be investigating grouping and sharing, 2D and 3D shape including manipulating, composing and decomposing and exploring position.

Science

In science the children will be investigating and exploring animals and comparing different environments.



PE

This term the children will be developing their skills in games. Thinking about how to work together through the themes of countries and places in the world.

PSHE

Our Jigsaw theme this half term is 'Changing Me'. The children will be thinking about their year in Reception and learning how to cope positively with change.



English

Books

The children will be writing lists, postcards and describing different places in the world.

We will be continuing to work on letter formation and the reading and writing of cvc words and 'tricky' words.

In phonics the children will continue to consolidate the sounds that they already know and start to learn many new digraphs (2 letters one sound) and trigraphs (3 letters one sound).

History/Geography

The children will be finding out about and comparing different places in the world including the local area. They will be investigating and making simple maps.

RE

The children will be finding out about why God is important to Christians. They will be exploring the festival of Harvest and the Creation story and visiting our local church.

Music

In music this half term the children will be using tuned and untuned instruments. The children will continue to listen and respond to different music genres, identify the pulse and rhythm and learn to sing new songs.
